Goal: Raise \$1500. in 15 days

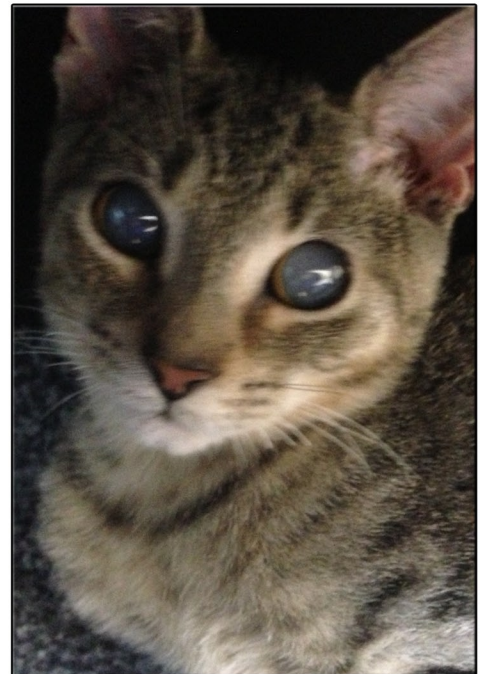
to save this kitty's eyesight and give him the second chance he needs to live a long and happy life.
